

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Admission is at the sole discretion of the festival organiser. Admission is subject to the conditions below - for safety and enjoyment of the festival experience.

1. Open fires are not permitted on any part of the festival site. Camping stoves and charcoal BBQs are permitted. Please ensure safe distance from tentage. Avoid damaging the grass by raising disposable BBQ's off the ground. No pyrotechnics allowed.
2. Strict five mph vehicle speed limit on site.
3. Clear up all litter and waste material. Please leave the site clean and litter free. Take your litter home as there are no collection facilities
4. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
5. The playing of amplified music is strictly forbidden on the camp site. Acoustic jam sessions are the order of the day.
6. Wristbands must be worn on the wrist at all times. Wristbands and tickets must be shown to festival staff on demand.
7. Camp and park only in the designated areas avoiding blocking access points onto or off of the festival site.
